A few weeks ago, we were thrilled to receive the container with dental chairs and equipment for the Compassion Community Dental Clinic at Nyamata Hospital. The chairs were donated and shipped to HHOA at no cost from DCI - an industry leader providing dental equipment to dentists and hygienists around the world.

Without a forklift, the off-loading took lots of manual labor! Once that was done, the installation of the chairs was next. One local technician wanted \$2000 to assemble the four chairs! That \$2000 would cover a Rwandan dentist's salary for more than two months! That being the case, guess who assembled and installed the chairs? Not to brag, but Dr. T. L, DDS, and our HHOA Rwanda team!!!
